According to the 2019 National Survey on Drug Use and Health, 9.7 million people misused prescription pain relievers, 4.9 million people misused prescription stimulants, and 5.9 million people misused prescription tranquilizers or sedatives in 2019. Young people must protect their brain development, refuse to take medications that are not prescribed to them, and encourage their family to properly dispose of unused and unwanted medications.
